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The BWF Heritage Project of the Year Award recognises excellence in a conservation, restoration or renovation application.

Judging Criteria

The Award will be judged against the following criteria:

- The company as a whole.
- A product supplied, or work undertaken, by the company.

The Award will be judged against any of the following criteria:

Craftsmanship – A heritage joinery project that demonstrates excellence in woodworking/joinery.

Evidence – That the company has contributed to the conservation, restoration or renovation of a heritage project through the application of traditional or modern woodworking techniques.

Design – Overcoming particular technical performance, or process difficulties, or exploiting new concepts to produce the desired joinery solution(s).

Excellence and Achievement – Overcoming particular technical performance, or process difficulties, or exploiting new concepts to produce the desired joinery solution(s).

Entry Requirements

To enter, complete this Award entry form and submit with the following information:

- Tell us about the initiative, company, or individual that shows how the entry meets the criteria.
- Photographs and any applicable technical drawings. All photographs and/or drawings to be sent in a separate digital file – either JPEG or EPS format.

Judges Tips



- ✓ Describe the project in detail – detail how any challenges were overcome.
- ✓ Explain how design and craftsmanship were used to achieve the desired outcome.
- ✓ Clearly address the judging criteria for the award.
- ✓ Include details of any client testimonials or accolades received.
- ✓ Include high quality relevant photos – a picture tells a thousand words.

Entry Rules

- Award Entries are invited for technical excellence and design for a heritage woodworking/joinery project.
- You can submit an entry for an individual, company or project.
- For each Award category you can submit up to two entries per company.
- Nominations can be made directly by the company, or you can nominate another company.
- Entries can be submitted for the same project in multiple Award categories.
- Previous winners cannot be submitted.
- Entry form and all accompanying documentation must be received by no later than **17.00 on Friday 30th August 2024.**
